

# Long-Term CARE Services



## What are Long-Term Care Services?

Long-Term Care Services are a range of personal support, community, physical and mental health care services.

These services are available to adults and seniors regardless of medical diagnosis.

## Who are the services for?

For those who are limited in their ability to carry out normal daily activities on a long-term basis (examples: walking, bathing, preparing meals), and whose family or friends are no longer able to provide the necessary care.

## How is eligibility determined?

*By measuring:*

- how the person functions on a day-to-day basis.
- the level of care and supervision required.

## Where are these services provided?

Long-term care services may be provided in your own home or in another residential setting.

## Who will pay for my care?

Long-term care services are not covered by Medicare. Your income will be considered in determining what you will pay. The government pays for those who are unable to pay the full cost of their services.

## How do I find out if I am eligible?

By contacting your local Family and Community Services office, your local Mental Health Services office or the Extra Mural Program in your area.
