



Time Line Considerations

There are a number of steps involved in developing your proposal for the Active Communities Grant Program. In order to work towards a successful application, allow enough time.

This section of the Grant Information gives you a general idea of the process involved.

How it works...

1. Discuss with others ... what does your community need?
2. If your proposal is for a community - contact your Regional Consultant. If your proposal is province wide - contact a Provincial Consultant.
3. If after discussion, you and the consultant agree that your proposal addresses the objectives of the Active Communities Grant Program, an application form will be provided.
4. Work through the application and complete it. Continued staff support will be available.
5. Submit your application to a Sport, Recreation & Active Living consultant
6. Your application will be reviewed.
7. Upon notification of a successful application– start implementing your great ideas!

You will need to begin organizing the information required for your application well in advance.

Asking yourself these questions may be helpful:

- How much time will it take for you to meet with partner(s) organization(s)?
- How much support will be needed from the Department of Wellness, Culture & Sport consultants to meet the details of the application?
- How much time will be needed to activate the project once you hear about the approval?
